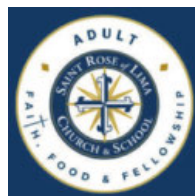

PART-TIME PSR ASSISTANT

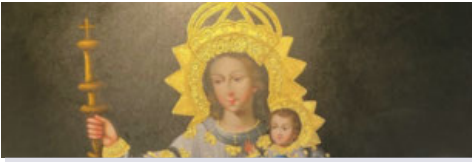
