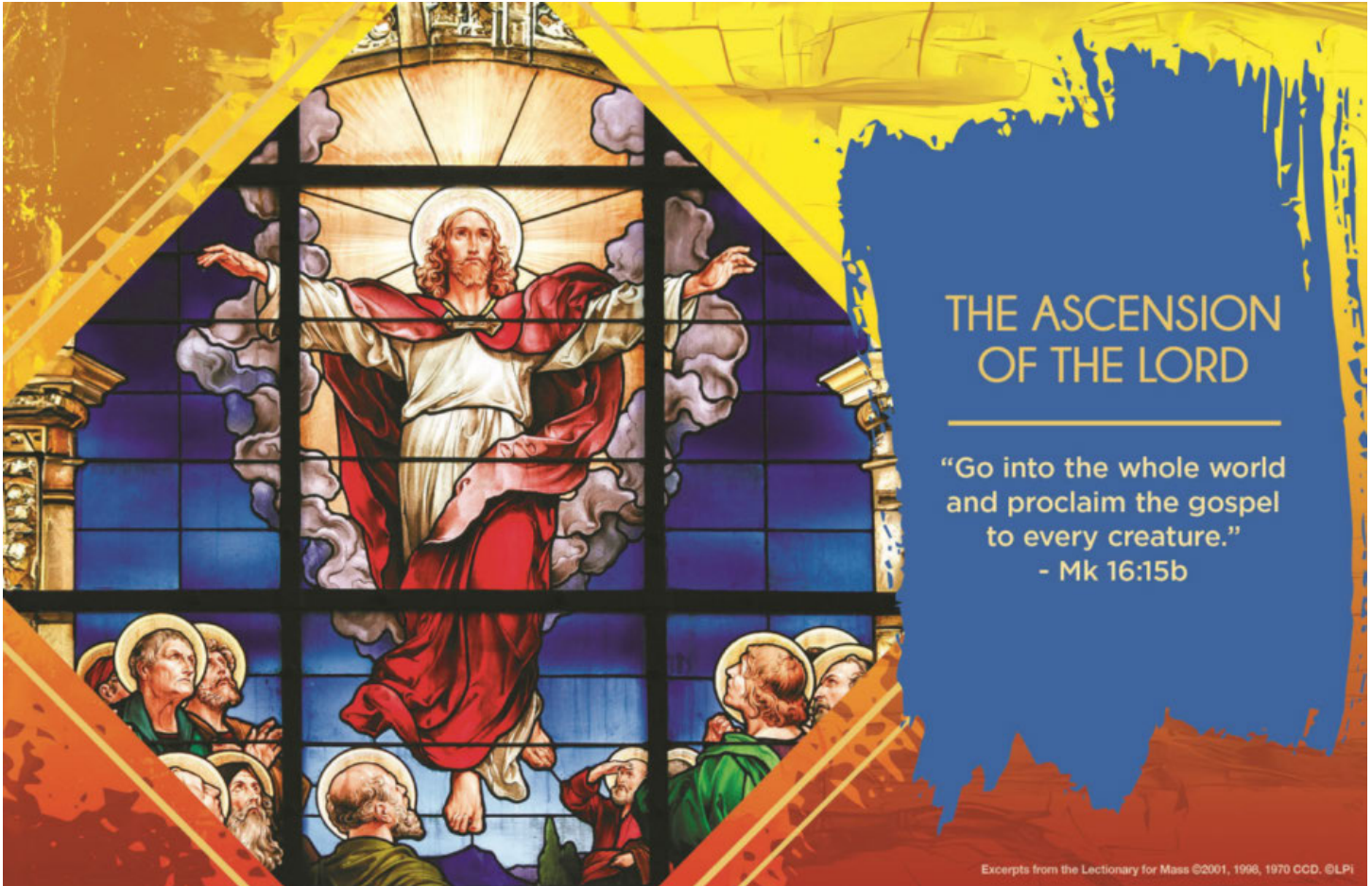

Event instructions: You will need to figure out transportation back to St. Rose of Lima in Murfreesboro. If you want to process shorter distance (4 miles) that day you could park your second car at General Bragg Trailhead where we will stop to eat lunch. There are no places to purchase lunch there. Dear Fellow Disciples, peace.



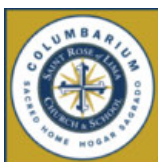
The Ascension of Jesus marks the conclusion of His earthly ministry. The mission now is entrusted to the disciples to “go throughout the world and bring the good news”. This is the missionary mandate we all have received from the earlier Church all the way to today’s disciples.

In the living out of this mission, the disciple is aware that he or she is sent by the risen Christ, not by his own initiative. He is also aware that the mission is universal, not limited to a place and time nor to a specific people. Here no discrimination is allowed by the risen Lord. We are sent to continue the ministry of Jesus, crucified and risen, to announce the Good News and sow the seeds of the Kingdom. To baptize in the theology of Mark is necessary for salvation.

Through these signs God manifests His care towards the needy and His protection for his disciples. SAINT ROSE COLUMBARIUM UPDATE: Over the past few weeks Fr. Chris, the Saint Rose Parish Council and Bishop Spalding have granted the Saint Rose Columbarium Exploratory Committee formal permission to proceed with the Diocesan feasibility study required to add a columbarium to our campus.

What is a Columbarium? A columbarium is an outdoor structure with niches (compartments) where urns containing the cremains of our loved ones are placed. For many raised in the Catholic Church a Columbarium is a new concept, though it has its roots in the early church. A Columbarium at St. Rose will offer parishioners and their families the option to make St. Rose their final sacred home.

Does the Catholic Church allow cremation? "...The Catholic Church permits cremation, provided that it does not demonstrate a denial of faith in the resurrection of the body." Catechism of the Catholic Church #2301. The Church wants to insure that we are interred in a sacred Place on Consecrated Ground so that we are never excluded from the prayers of our Catholic Community. A Columbarium on St. Rose grounds would ensure a dignified resting place where we would never be forgotten in prayer as we await the joyful hope of the coming of our Savior.

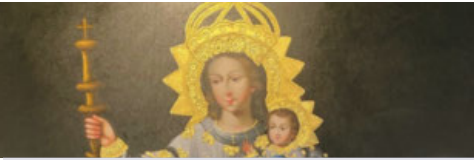

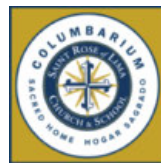

¿Qué es un columbario? Un columbario es una estructura al aire libre con nichos (compartimentos) donde se colocan urnas que contienen las cremas de nuestros seres queridos. Para muchos criados en la Iglesia Católica, un Columbario es un concepto nuevo, aunque tiene sus raíces en la iglesia primitiva. 
