Baptismal Certificate

A copy of the baptismal certificate must be turned in to the Church Office at registration.

Canon Law requires that a candidate be baptized before receiving Confirmation. The Baptismal Certificate provides proof to St. Rose Parish that you have been baptized. Additionally, upon the occasion of your Confirmation, your sacramental records must be updated. This is reported back to the parish of Baptism where all subsequent records are held. This will ensure that all instances of significant sacramental activity are recorded.

The Church where you were baptized is the only place where these records are held, the baptismal certificate must be obtained from this parish.

What if I was baptized at St. Rose?

Then we will have your records. Please contact the Church Office, 615-893-1843, to verify.

I wasn't baptized at St. Rose, but I received First Communion here, I had to give them a copy of the baptismal certificate at that time, don't they still have it?

No. The record of your First Communion was sent back to the parish of Baptism. Your baptismal certificate must be obtained again from the parish where you were baptized.

What if I was baptized outside of the United States?

Your baptismal certificate must still be obtained. Please call 615-893-1843 if you need assistance obtaining your baptismal certificate.
