

EUCCHARISTIC DAY

Long before any of us had heard of the pandemic, our Saint Rose Amazing Parish team had conceived of the ideal of a Eucharistic Congress to take place next weekend. I won't go into the details of the grandiose plans we had projected. Of course, when the pandemic did come such plans were shelved. About the only physical sign of the Eucharistic Congress is a note on our parish calendar. We were planning ahead!

Now that we are emerging from our second pandemic spike, I wanted to propose the idea of a more modest Eucharistic Day on Saturday, November 20. There isn't time to do much else; and yet, emphasis on the Eucharist has become our bishops' highest priority in the meantime.

I am happy that we are able to resurrect some special plans in honor of our encounter with Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament here at Saint Rose as we prepare to celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King next Sunday. Stay tuned!

Three Eucharistic Miracles



"This is My Body...this is My Blood...Behold the Lamb of God!" We regularly hear these words at Mass. Unfortunately, it is too easy to forget how blessed we are as Catholics to really receive the Lord Jesus in the Eucharist. Though He remains hidden under the appearances of bread and wine, we actually receive the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus. Sometimes, He allows miracles to happen to reaffirm this constant teaching of the Church. Come listen to three miraculous stories that attest to the Real Presence. The first, St. Anthony and the atheist's mule (1220's), is a story of one of God's irrational creatures recognizing his creator more quickly than his "rational" owner. The Miracle of Lanciano (720's), is a story of a renewal of faith in the Real Presence for a monk whose love for science was great, but his love for God had grown cold. The final story, the miracle of Sokolka (2008), is a story from Poland that affirms the Real Presence of the Lord in the Eucharist.

This presentation will also outline scientific studies surrounding the events at Lanciano and Sokolka that have led doctors and scientists who have researched these events to conclude that they are miraculous.

Fr. Anthony Stephens, C.P.M. Biographical information



Fr. Tony was born in 1976 and is a native of Angelus, Kansas. He graduated from a public high school in 1995, and afterwards he attended Christendom College in Front Royal Virginia. Discerning a call to religious life and the priesthood, he joined the Fathers of Mercy in 2000. In 2001, Fr. Tony professed the three vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience, and then he studied for the priesthood at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, Ohio. While at the Josephinum, he received his Master of Divinity degree. He was ordained a priest in 2005, and he served for two years as the assistant pastor of St. Luke's Catholic Church in Nicholasville, KY. In 2007, Fr. Tony was assigned to begin traveling and preaching parish retreats, also known as "parish missions". His travels have taken him all over the United States, into Canada, and also to different parts of the Australian Continent. From 2009-2015, he served as the Vocations Director and Student Master for the community. During this time, he also helped out part time in the preaching apostolate of the Congregation. Beginning in August of 2015, he joined the formation faculty at the Mt. St. Mary's of the West in Cincinnati, OH, where he worked as the Vice Rector and Director of Formation until the Spring of 2021. He is currently a member of the traveling missionaries for the Fathers of Mercy.

The Congregation of the Fathers of Mercy was founded in 1808, originally under the title of "the Missionaries of France." The community was founded for the purpose of re-evangelizing the French people after the Catholic Faith had been subjected to years of attacks and persecution during the French Revolution. It is now an exclusively American community, headquartered in South Union, Kentucky. The primary apostolate of the Fathers of Mercy is to conduct parish missions and retreats in effort to re-evangelize and revitalize the faith of those who seek God's Truth and Mercy.

HAND CARVED OLIVE WOOD RELIGIOUS ARTICLES - Jo Call Room Nov. 27-28


Khader & Mary Abusada, a Catholic couple from the Holy Land, will be visiting our parish to market olive wood hand carved religious articles made by the Christian artisans in the Holy Land. With the hostilities worsening in the Holy Land and the lack of Christian pilgrims, the outlets for the olive wood hand carvings have been closed. This has forced many Christians to leave the Holy Land in order to find other ways to market their handiwork. The absence of a living Christian community is very disastrous for the Holy sites, such as the Church of the Nativity and the Church of the Holy Sepulcher.

This sale is to strengthen the Christian presence in the city of Bethlehem and the surrounding areas. All proceeds will go directly to the Christian families and the artisans who are working in this type of hand carvings. All kinds of olive wood religious art works will be available for purchase such as: Nativity scenes, Crucifixes, figures, rosaries, etc. These are unique and not usually found in religious stores and make wonderful presents for all occasions, especially Christmas. The price range is from \$5 to \$900.

WHAT IS EUCHARISTIC ADORATION?

During Eucharistic Adoration, the faithful pray to Jesus Christ, who is present in the Eucharist. The Eucharist, also referred to as the Blessed Sacrament, is typically kept in a tabernacle at your parish church.

While it is true that you can pray to God anywhere and that He is always within you, it is especially powerful to adore Jesus in the Eucharist. In the presence of the Eucharist, we pray to the power and sacrifice that it represents – the body of Jesus, who gave His life so that we may live.

It is His body, blood, soul and divinity that is really, truly, and substantially present in the Eucharist.

We adore and receive the Eucharist in communion at Mass, which is the most beautiful act of worship that we have as Catholics. We have Jesus truly present in all of the tabernacles around the world. We can continue to adore Him in the Eucharist after Mass in a quiet time of prayer and contemplation on Who we have just received . Being in the presence of the body, blood, soul and divinity of Jesus Christ gives spiritual strength and nourishment in a uniquely powerful way.




