

HAITI UPDATE

The kids and our amazing agronomist, Renold, have been busy working in the school garden. Each month, Renold sends a budget with a list of needed items. The funds sent in July will cover the cost of the next coumbite. A coumbite is a gathering of the kids and other community members to prepare the gardens for planting. They will be planting cabbage, tomatoes, lettuce and peppers. This is a full day's work, so they will receive a meal as well. Renold is also setting back a little money each month to build a larger water retention area to store water for future use. Thank you again for your support of Haiti!
