


IN THE NAME OF THE TRINITY Dear Fellow Disciples, peace.

The disciples of the Kingdom are baptized "in the name of the Father and of Son and of the Holy Spirit".

"In the name of" means that their life brings the mark of the Most Holy Trinity and through her, are knitted. Their existence takes a new dimension, transcendental, giving them the dignity of sons and daughters of God.

SAINT ROSE COLUMBARIUM UPDATE:

The Saint Rose Columbarium Exploratory Committee continues to meet once a week. New projects include: planning for the Parish Columbarium Survey, Parish education about our Columbarium project and preliminary investigation of various Columbarium design firms.

Where might the columbarium be located? With input from Fr. Chris, Wayne Overman from the Master Plan and other parish leaders the space behind the Church Office known as "Mary's Grotto," where the statue of our Blessed Mother now stands, has been selected. It provides a peaceful, quiet, private space right next to the Church.

Will the Columbarium be built all at once? The entire Columbarium complex will be designed with 200 years of Saint Rose needs in mind. However, construction will follow in a planned series of Phases as the need in the future arises.

Who will pay for the Columbarium? All costs for construction and future maintenance of the Saint Rose Columbarium will be paid for entirely by the sale of the niches in the Columbarium. No Parish Stewardship Funds or Master Plan Building Funds will be used. Before any construction of the Saint Rose Columbarium can begin, there must be enough funds generated by the PRE-SALE of NICHES in not more than a 1 year period to cover all of the Phase 1 construction costs and a Trust Fund to cover all future maintenance costs.

PARISH COUNCIL ELECTIONS

In a very close race Lucy Matthews, Alex Melhorn, and Amy Waggener were elected to the English-speaking openings on the Parish Council. Two candidates, Nelson Gonzalez and Jose Portillo from our Spanish-speaking community have been appointed by Fr. Chris to fill the two openings for that community. Congratulations to these candidates and we are grateful for all those who were willing to serve.

WORKING TOWARD A SANCTUARY

Saint Rose of Lima Parish is in a unique position: we have the opportunity to live out the encyclical of Pope Francis', Laudato Sí, which endorses care of God's creation.

The Saint Rose of Lima Woodland Sanctuary is approximately 30 acres to the north of the church and school. It has been untouched for more than 60 years. This neglect has yielded both negative consequences – the area is very dense with invasive and overgrown vegetation, and positive – the area has been left to develop as a healthy wetland ecosystem that has unusual native flora and fauna.

Recently, Saint Rose was awarded a grant from the USDA that will reimburse the parish up to \$17,523 for removal of invasive plants and timber stand improvement. Additionally, The

Murfreesboro Indigenous Plant Project (MIPP), is interested in collecting seeds from the native plants and trees in our woodland. The woodland can be considered a living laboratory for STEM activities and the school science program. One suggestion is to have an outdoor education classroom. Our woodland is a perfect place for prayer, quiet reflection, perhaps with Stations of the Cross and a Grotto, and gentle recreation on a walking trail.

The Woodland Sanctuary Committee made up of parishioners, will be formed to help guide and inform our leadership in developing uses of the woodland, while conserving and preserving the gift of God's creation. Please contact Idoddkarl@ saintrose.org for information.





La Parroquia Santa Rosa de Lima se encuentra en una posición única: tenemos la oportunidad de vivir la encíclica del Papa Francisco, *Laudato Sí*, que respalda el cuidado de la creación de Dios.

El Santuario Woodland de Santa Rosa de Lima está aproximadamente a 30 acres al norte de la iglesia y la escuela. Ha estado intacto durante más de 60 años. Este abandono ha tenido consecuencias tanto negativas (el área es muy densa con vegetación invasora y cubierta de maleza) como positivas (se ha dejado que el área se desarrolle como un ecosistema de humedal saludable que tiene una flora y fauna nativa inusual).

Recientemente, Saint Rose recibió una subvención del USDA que reembolsará a la parroquia hasta \$17,523 por la eliminación de plantas invasoras y la mejora de los bosques. Además, el Proyecto de Plantas Indígenas de Murfreesboro (MIPP) está interesado en recolectar semillas de plantas y árboles nativos de nuestro bosque. El bosque puede considerarse un laboratorio viviente para las actividades STEM y el programa de ciencias de la escuela. Una sugerencia es tener un aula de educación al aire libre. Nuestro bosque es un lugar perfecto para la oración, la reflexión tranquila, tal vez con el Vía Crucis y una Gruta, y una suave recreación en un sendero para caminar.

El Comité del Santuario del Bosque, compuesto por feligreses, se formará para ayudar a guiar e informar a nuestro liderazgo en el desarrollo de usos del bosque, mientras se conserva y preserva el regalo de la creación de Dios. Comuníquese con **Idoddkarl@saintrose.org** para obtener información.
