PREJUDICE BLOCKS FAITH

Dear Fellow Disciples, peace.

Jesus was a victim of a lot of prejudice by his countrymen. His good news of the Kingdom was met with suspicion and questioning. This attitude has its origin in their knowledge of Jesus' origin. They knew his town, his family, his profession. Coming from humble beginnings was a stumbling block for them to believe and trust in his teachings. He taught them as someone who had authority. The miracles which accompanied his teaching also brought prejudice and suspicion. His challenging attitude towards them and the signs shocked them and they rejected him.



At the root of their prejudice, especially of the leadership of Nazareth, there was a double mistake. First they thought that God chooses only people of high social and religious positions. People with a vast cultural baggage, whose masters were well known and renowned. Secondly refers to a certain inferiority complex which excluded the possibility of someone like them to be chosen as a prophet. They could not believe that someone who shared their humble origin could speak in the name of God and work miracles.

The experience of the old prophets permitted Jesus to understand what was going on in them. That's why He was not intimidated. Rather, He went on fulfilling the mission entrusted to him by the Father.

Sometimes and for different reasons people today have the same attitude towards God, the Church and religion. We as disciples of Jesus, who strive to be His presence and to do His work in today's world are more than ever called to be truthful and compassionate at the same time. We are encouraged by the example of Jesus to carry on our mission entrusted to us by Him and to not let prejudice, ours or the other's, to freeze us.

May the Holy Spirit keep urging us forward in this mission.

SAINT ROSE COLUMBARIUM UPDATE:



We have had a lot of great and interesting inquiries concerning our Columbarium so this week we will address a few.

Can my cremated remains be mixed with the cremated remains of other individuals, pets or other objects? No. These practices have never been allowed by the Catholic Church. The Catholic Church also forbids

the spreading of ashes in rivers, lakes or forests etc. Our Saint Rose Columbarium niches will be able to hold up to 2 separate urns in each.

What happens if I purchase a niche and the Saint Rose Columbarium is not built? Our Nashville Diocese requires that before our Columbarium can begin to be built, enough niches must be sold in just 12 months to fund all Phase 1 construction and endow a trust fund to cover all future maintenance. If enough niches are not pre-sold in 12 months all funds paid for niches must be refunded. All of the Phase 1 niches do not have to be pre-sold; just enough must be pre-sold to fund construction and the maintenance trust fund.

Do I own my niche? No. A niche purchase does not constitute a sale of property but is the provision for an eternal burial space in our Columbarium. All ownership of the land, Columbarium and surrounding gardens will remain with our Saint Rose of Lima Parish.

Who will administer the ongoing activity of our Columbarium? A Saint Rose Columbarium Board will be formed that will manage the niche sales, upkeep, future expansion and maintenance of our Columbarium funded by niche sales only.

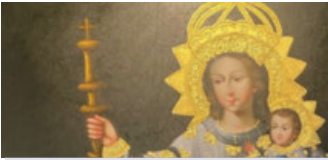

XIV DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

EL PREJUICIO BLOQUEA LA FE

Queridos discípulos, paz.

Jesús fue víctima de muchos prejuicios por parte de sus compatriotas. Sus buenas noticias del Reino fueron recibidas con sospecha y cuestionamientos. Esta actitud tiene su origen en su conocimiento del origen de Jesús. Conocían su ciudad, su familia, su profesión. Viniendo de sus humildes comienzos fue un obstáculo para que creyeran y confiaran en sus enseñanzas. Les enseñó como alguien que tenía autoridad. Los milagros que acompañaron a su enseñanza también trajeron prejuicios y sospechas. Su actitud desafiante hacia ellos y las señales los sorprendieron y lo rechazaron.

En la raíz de sus prejuicios, especialmente del liderazgo de Nazaret, hubo un doble error. Primero pensaron que Dios elige solo a las personas de altas posiciones sociales y religiosas. Personas con un vasto conocimiento cultural, cuyos maestros eran bien conocidos y reconocidos. En segundo lugar, se refiere a un cierto complejo de inferioridad que excluía la posibilidad de que alguien como ellos fuera elegido como profeta. No podían creer que alguien que compartía su humilde origen pudiera hablar en el nombre de Dios y hacer milagros.

La experiencia de los viejos profetas permitió a Jesús entender lo que estaba pasando en ellos. Por eso no se sintió intimidado. Más bien, cumplió con la misión que le confió el Padre.

A veces y por diferentes razones, la gente de hoy en día tiene la misma actitud hacia Dios, la Iglesia y la religión. Nosotros, como discípulos de Jesús, que nos esforzamos por ser Su presencia y hacer Su trabajo en el mundo de hoy, estamos más llamados que nunca a ser sinceros y compasivos al mismo tiempo. Nos anima el ejemplo de Jesús a llevar a cabo nuestra misión que Él nos ha confiado y a no dejar que los prejuicios, de nosotros mismos o de los demás, nos congelen.

Que el Espíritu Santo nos siga instando a avanzar en esta misión.

ACTUALIZACIÓN DEL COLUMBARIO DE SAINT ROSE: Hemos recibido muchas consultas interesantes sobre nuestro Columbario, por lo que esta semana abordaremos algunas.

¿Se pueden mezclar mis restos cremados con restos cremados de otras personas, mascotas u otros objetos? No. Estas prácticas nunca han sido permitidas por la Iglesia Católica. La Iglesia Católica también prohíbe esparcir cenizas en ríos, lagos o bosques, etc. Nuestros nichos del Columbario Santa Rosa podrán contener hasta 2 urnas separadas en cada uno.

¿Qué pasa si compro un nicho y el Columbario Santa Rosa no está construido? Nuestra Diócesis de Nashville requiere que antes de que se pueda comenzar a construir nuestro Columbario, se deben vender suficientes nichos en solo 12 meses para financiar toda la construcción de la Fase 1 y dotar un fondo fiduciario para cubrir todo el mantenimiento futuro. Si no se venden suficientes nichos en 12 meses, se deben reembolsar todos los fondos pagados por los nichos. No es necesario vender previamente todos los nichos de la Fase 1; se debe vender previamente lo suficiente para financiar la construcción y el fondo fiduciario de mantenimiento.

¿Quién administrará la actividad continua de nuestro Columbario? Se formará una Junta del Columbario Santa Rosa que gestionará las ventas de nicho, el mantenimiento, la expansión futura y el mantenimiento de nuestro Columbario financiado únicamente por ventas de nicho.

CAPITAL PROGRAM UPDATE

Master Plan and Funding:

This spring we presented our comprehensive campus plan to various stakeholders and parishioners, outlining the funding requirements and interim milestones for each major phase of the program. While contributions have been steady, they have not reached the level necessary for the major projects needed. We hope parishioners will recognize the importance of having adequate facilities for present and future needs, as did the visionaries that previously laid the foundation of our present campus.

Marian Center Renovation:

We have received approval from the diocese to enter into a design contract with Bauer Askew Architects for the design of a New Marian Center. Fr. Chris and Saint Rose senior staff met with Tom Bauer on June 27 to review concept renderings of the new facility. These renderings will be available to the parish for viewing in the coming weeks. Wisser Consultants have been engaged to develop parking and utility plans for the new Marian Center. These plans will also be displayed alongside the Marian Center renderings.

Storage Facilities at 1522 Stonewall:

Steve James has been engaged to prepare concept drawings for a storage building on the 1522 Stonewall property. These drawings should be ready for display next month.

Athletic Field Relocation:

Gresham Smith has completed the site investigation for a new ball field and soccer/football field. A concept layout will be on display in the narthex starting July 6. We are tentatively set to meet with the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation in early August as we will need to impact a small section of wetland to develop our campus properly.

ACTUALIZACIÓN DEL PROGRAMA DE CAPITAL

Plan maestro y financiación:

Esta primavera presentamos nuestro plan integral del campus a varias partes interesadas y feligreses, describiendo los requisitos de financiación y los hitos provisionales para cada fase principal del programa. Si bien las contribuciones han sido constantes, no han alcanzado el nivel necesario para los grandes proyectos necesarios. Esperamos que los feligreses reconozcan la importancia de tener instalaciones adecuadas para las necesidades presentes y futuras, como lo hicieron los visionarios que anteriormente sentaron las bases de nuestro campus actual.

Renovación del Centro Mariano:

Hemos recibido la aprobación de la diócesis para firmar un contrato de diseño con Bauer Askew Architects para el diseño de un nuevo Marian Center. El padre Chris y el personal superior de Santa Rosa se reunieron con Tom Bauer el 27 de junio para revisar los diseños conceptuales de la nueva instalación. Estos diseños estarán disponibles para que la parroquia los vea en las próximas semanas. Se ha contratado a Wisser Consultants para desarrollar los planos de estacionamiento y servicios públicos para el nuevo Marian Center. Estos planos también se mostrarán junto con los diseños del Marian Center.

Lugar de almacenamiento en 1522 Stonewall:

Steve James ha sido contratado para preparar los planos conceptuales para un edificio de almacenamiento en la propiedad de 1522 Stonewall. Estos planos deberían estar listos para exhibirse el próximo mes.

Reubicación del campo de atletismo:

Gresham Smith ha completado la investigación del sitio para un nuevo campo de béisbol y un campo de fútbol. Se exhibirá un plano conceptual en el nártex a partir del 6 de julio. Tenemos previsto reunirnos provisionalmente con el Departamento de Medio Ambiente y Conservación de Tennessee a principios de agosto, ya que necesitaremos impactar una pequeña sección de humedal para desarrollar nuestro campus de manera adecuada.
