Dear Fellow Disciples, peace.

SAINT ROSE COLUMBARIUM UPDATE:



The Parish Columbarium Survey Ballot has been finalized and was approved by the Parish Council! Voting is planned for this fall. On this ballot every family will simply be asked to vote YES or NO regarding the installation of a Columbarium at Saint Rose. This is not a vote asking if you are in favor of cremation or plan to purchase a niche; it is just a vote asking if you are in favor of a columbarium on our Saint Rose of

Lima campus.

Who will be eligible to utilize the Saint Rose Columbarium? Internment in our Columbarium is currently planned to be available to all current and former members of our Saint Rose Parish community and their immediate family members. All others may be considered on a case by case basis by the Saint Rose Columbarium Board.

Will non-Catholics be allowed to be interred in our Columbarium? YES. If a Saint Rose parishioner is married to a non-Catholic or has non-Catholics in their immediate family, they are planned to be allowed to utilize our Columbarium so families can remain together in their Sacred Home.

If cremated, can there still be a Funeral Mass and Committal Service? YES. A traditional Catholic Funeral Mass can be performed before or after cremation and may include a Committal Service immediately following the Funeral Mass at our very own Columbarium right outside our Church with a bereavement reception, if desired, in the Jo Call Room.

¿Quién será elegible para utilizar el Columbario Santa Rosa? 



BUILDING NEW TO REPLACE THE MARIAN CENTER

After lengthy investigation and consultation with active parishioners, church and school employees, ministry leaders and volunteers, the decision has been made and approved by the Parish Council, to build a new structure to replace the current **Marian Center** building. The assessment concluded that space is desperately needed to accommodate present and future needs for a growing parish and school.

Most know that availability of the Jo Call Room is very limited due to frequent use. Also, many of our available spaces are currently not suitable for work or meetings. This limits the needs of the many groups and ministries of the parish and school. Furthermore, our outreach programs would be best situated apart from the school building with dedicated space that is more suitable and offers complete accessibility.

In addition to housing the Backpack and Bridge ministries, The Food Pantry and Saint Rose Radio, the new building will also serve as a meeting space for large groups (50 or more people). Prior to demolition of the current Marian Center, a storage unit will be built adjacent to the Stonewall house. This building will store equipment used by the Boy Scouts and the Troops of St. George, as well as other materials for the parish and school. These items will be stored so that they will be easily accessible for future use.
