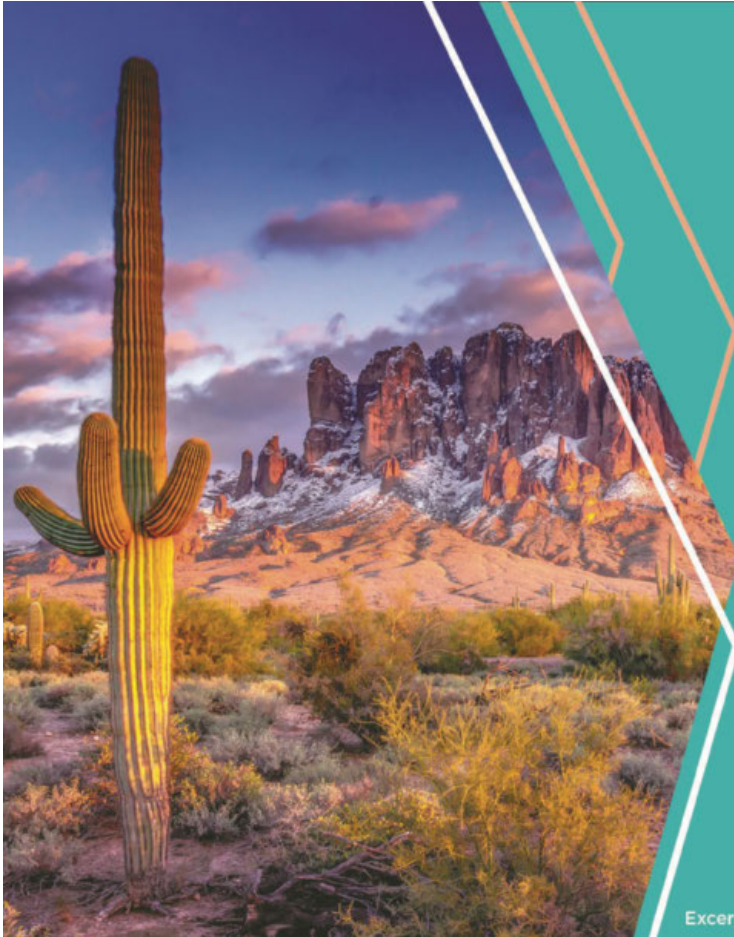

FOOD FOR ETERNAL LIFE

Dear Fellow Disciples, peace.

Jesus' statement, "*I am the bread that came down from heaven*", was misinterpreted by his adversaries, as we already expected. They interpret it in the literal sense, to accuse him of encouraging anthropophagy.



The metaphoric language of Jesus, even though the Eucharist is not a metaphor, brought to his listeners a theme very dear to them, the mana that came down from heaven, as food for the hungry people in the desert.

Jesus, the Master, understood himself to be the true food, sent by the Father, for the pilgrim people, who had no direction, in the desert of life. His presence in their life should cause the same effect of the mana in the lives of the people of Israel in the desert.

Jesus is the "*living bread*", the bread of life, encouragement, strength in the people's journey, in our journey. This bread enforces in the human heart the sense of hope and trust as we strive as his disciples, to build up a world according to the Father's will. It will quench the thirst of meaning in our lives, as we strive to conquer the feelings of discouragement which sometimes impede us to move forward.

The bread of life, Jesus in the Eucharist, is, as St. Thomas Aquinas points it, "*food for the journey, remedy for immortality and pledge of eternal life*".

Come Holy Spirit, enkindle in our hearts a great love, devotion, reverence, and sense of awe for the Eucharist; the true presence of Jesus among us.

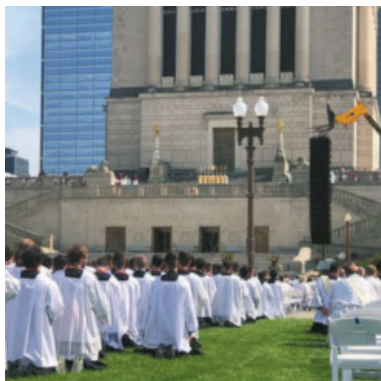

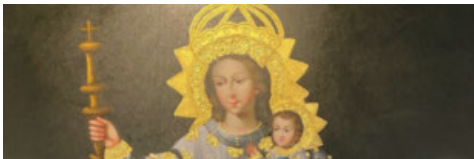


HEARING ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE

Queridos discípulos, paz.

La afirmación de Jesús: "Yo soy el pan bajado del cielo", fue malinterpretada por sus adversarios, como ya esperábamos. La interpretaron en sentido literal, para acusarlo de fomentar la antropofagia.

El lenguaje metafórico de Jesús, aunque la Eucaristía no es una metáfora, trajo a sus oyentes un tema muy querido para ellos, el maná bajado del cielo, como alimento para el pueblo hambriento del desierto.

Our goal is to have a full color design concept poster and video of our future Columbarium ready to display in the Church narthex before our Parish Survey.

Why have a Parish Survey vote? The Diocese of Nashville requires all Parishes to conduct a Survey of their Parishioners prior to constructing a Columbarium.

If I vote YES am I agreeing to purchase a Niche? NO. Your vote of YES only states that you think it is a good idea to have a Columbarium at Saint Rose of Lima for those Parishioners who wish to utilize it.

If I vote YES am I agreeing to cremation? NO. Whether or not a Catholic chooses tradition burial or cremation is an individual choice allowed by the Church. If you vote YES you are just saying that those Saint Rose Parishioners who chose cremation may have a final resting place at Saint Rose of Lima.

When is our Saint Rose Parish Survey going to take place? Plans are underway to conduct our Parish Survey this September.

Will my vote be anonymous and how will I vote in our Survey? YES. Anonymous print ballots approved by our Parish Council that do not need to be signed will be handed out at all Masses as well as an electronic voting option will be provided.

Is my vote important, I am not really interested? YES. Our Nashville Decease requires that 33% of all Parish Families vote in the Survey for it to be valid.

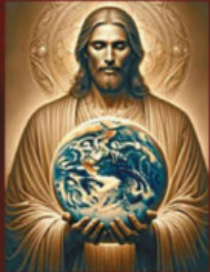
