Dear Fellow Disciples, peace.

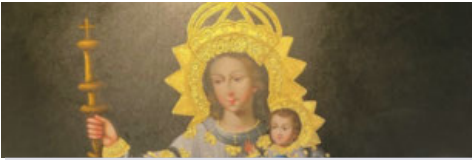


HEARING ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE

Marian Center

Design work for the new Marian Center is progressing. Bauer Askew Architects have delivered floor plans and renderings, which have been shared through various channels and are on display in the Narthex. Parishioners were invited to vote on the roof design, with over 90% favoring the gable roof option. On August 29, the Finance Committee reviewed the project along with the schematic-level cost estimates and gave their approval to proceed with the final design.

Storage Facilities at Stonewall House

To accommodate a larger storage building and additional parking at Stonewall House, a special exemption was required from the Murfreesboro Board of Zoning Appeals. This request was presented on August 28 and received approval. The Finance Committee, in their August 29 meeting, approved moving forward with the added parking. However, they recommended delaying construction of the large storage building to prioritize funding for the new Marian Center. Temporary storage solutions will be used for items currently housed in the Marian Center until the Stonewall storage building project can proceed.

Athletic Field Relocation

During an update to the wetland delineation of the Saint Rose of Lima Woodland Sanctuary (SRWS), we discovered the presence of the Tennessee Streamside Salamander (*Ambystomabarbouri*), a species of concern due to its limited range and specific habitat requirements. Although not currently listed as endangered or threatened, it requires monitoring. The construction of the athletic fields will impact approximately one acre of wetlands, necessitating an Aquatic Resource Alteration Permit (ARAP). If these wetlands are classified as "Waters of the U.S." or jurisdictional wetlands, a Corps 404 permit will also be required.

On August 7, we held a pre-regulatory meeting with the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation and the Corps of Engineers to discuss acceptable mitigation procedures. We are now preparing the necessary documentation for these permits. Once approved, we will proceed with the design phase of the athletic field relocation project.

More updates to come next week on the SRWS and the Columbarium. These updates are not included here as they are not funded by the Capital Campaign.

Centro Mariano

Trabajos de diseño para el nuevo Centro Mariano están avanzando. Bauer Askew Architects ha entregado planos de planta y representaciones, que se han compartido a través de varios canales y se exhiben en el Nártex. Se invitó a los feligreses a votar sobre el diseño del techo, y más del 90% favoreció la opción de techo a dos aguas. El 29 de agosto, el Comité de Finanzas revisó el proyecto junto con las estimaciones de costos a nivel esquemático y dio su aprobación para proceder con el diseño final.

Instalaciones de almacenamiento en Stonewall House

Para acomodar un edificio de almacenamiento más grande y estacionamiento adicional en Stonewall House, se requirió una exención especial de la Junta de Apelaciones de Zonificación de Murfreesboro. Esta solicitud fue presentada el 28 de agosto y recibió aprobación. El Comité de Finanzas, en su reunión del 29 de agosto, aprobó seguir adelante con la adición de estacionamiento. Sin embargo, recomendaron retrasar la construcción del gran edificio de almacenamiento para priorizar la financiación del nuevo Centro Mariano. Se utilizarán soluciones de almacenamiento temporal para los artículos que actualmente se encuentran en el Marian Center hasta que el proyecto del edificio de almacenamiento de Stonewall pueda continuar.

Reubicación del campo de atletismo

Durante una actualización de la delimitación del humedal del Santuario del Bosque de Santa Rosa de Lima (SRWS), descubrimos la presencia de la salamandra de arroyo de Tennessee (*Ambystomabarbouri*), una especie preocupante debido a su rango limitado y requisitos específicos de hábitat. Aunque actualmente no está catalogada como en peligro de extinción o amenazada, requiere monitoreo. La construcción de los campos deportivos afectará aproximadamente un acre de humedales, lo que requerirá un Permiso de Alteración de Recursos Acuáticos (ARAP). Si estos humedales están clasificados como "Aguas de los EE. UU." o humedales jurisdiccionales, también se requerirá un permiso del Cuerpo 404.

El 7 de agosto, celebramos una reunión prerregulatoria con el Departamento de Medio Ambiente y Conservación de Tennessee y el Cuerpo de Ingenieros para discutir los procedimientos de mitigación aceptables. Ahora estamos preparando la documentación necesaria para estos permisos. Una vez aprobado, procederemos con la fase de diseño del proyecto de reubicación del campo deportivo

La próxima semana habrá más actualizaciones sobre el SRWS y el Columbario. Estas actualizaciones no se incluyen aquí, ya que no están financiadas por la Campaña Capital.

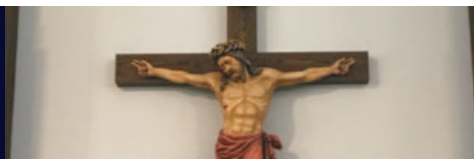

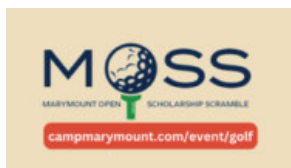
