Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

In the first reading from the Book of Numbers, we see Moses exclaim to Joshua, "Would that all the people of the Lord were prophets!" What exactly does it mean to be a prophet? For the people of the Old Covenant, it meant calling back the sinful Israelites and foretelling the doom they would undergo if they did not repent. It meant proclaiming

that one day God would send a savior, the Messiah, to right all the wrongs of the world. However, what does it mean to be a prophet under the New Covenant? It means being open to the movement of the Holy Spirit in our lives. It means proclaiming Christ crucified and risen from the dead. It means doing the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. It means living as if we truly believe God is real, that He loves us, that He has saved us, and that He calls us forth to go and do His work in the world.

HAITI UPDATE: There is a new, very exciting project we are working on for our parish in Haiti. We are in the process of connecting them with Starlink, a satellite internet service that provides high-speed internet around the world. Although Father Doristin does have the ability to use the internet through a modem, it isn't always reliable. Starlink would not only provide this for the church, but for the school as well, which has not been possible for them until now. This will be an incredible opportunity for the children. Starlink discounts the monthly fee for countries such as Haiti, so this will only cost \$50 per month. Father Doristin is very excited and grateful for this opportunity and is looking forward to how this will positively impact Notre Dame de la Merci. We will keep you all up to date as this progresses. As always, we praise God and thank you for your support which makes projects like this possible!

Hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,



Los mantendremos informados a medida que esto avance. Como siempre, alabamos a Dios y te damos las gracias por tu apoyo que hace posible proyectos como este.


