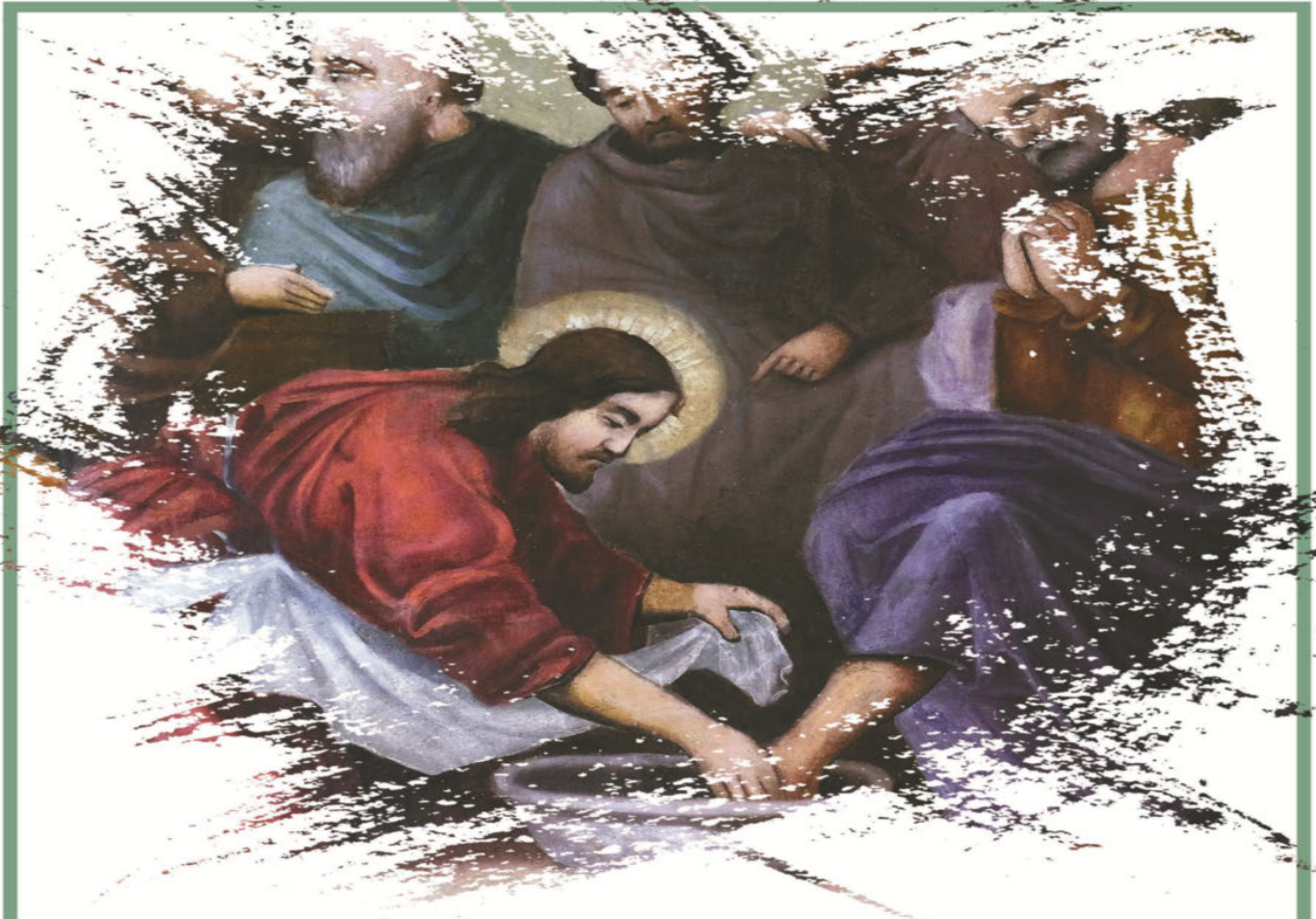

SAINT ROSE COLUMBARIUM UPDATE: After 9 months of planning and preparation by our Columbarium Exploratory Committee, the results of the Saint Rose of Lima Columbarium Parishioner Support Survey required by the Diocese of Nashville have been totaled. **THE RESULTS DEMONSTRATED OVERWHELMING SUPPORT BY SAINT ROSE OF LIMA PARISHIONERS TO BUILD A COLUMBARIUM ON OUR CAMPUS!** Participation and results of the survey exceeded all of the Diocese of Nashville's Requirements.

How many parish families were required to participate? The Diocese requires 33% of parish families to participate. At the time of voting we had 3,361 families at Saint Rose, 1,248 of them voted. Thus we had 37.1% participation.

How many votes were required to be in favor of a columbarium at Saint Rose? The Diocese requires 75% of those voting in the survey to be in favor of a columbarium. Our results show that 1,143 families are in favor of the columbarium or 91.6%.

What will happen next? These results and many more required facts and figures will be officially presented to the Diocese of Nashville for approval. Watch the parish Bulletin for future updates.

HIS LIFE IS SERVICE, OURS SHOULD BE ALSO!

Dear Fellow Disciples, peace.

This Sunday the readings focus on themes of service, humility, and the example of Jesus Christ as the Suffering Servant.

In today's Gospel, James and John approach Jesus with a bold request: they want places of honor when Jesus comes into His glory. They're imagining positions of power and prestige. But Jesus responds in a way they don't expect, and maybe even in a way we don't expect. He says, "Whoever wishes to be great among you must be your servant, and whoever wishes to be first among you must be the slave of all." At first glance, this seems upside down. We usually think greatness comes with power, authority, and control. But Jesus turns this idea on its head. True greatness, He says, is not about being served but about serving others. It's about humility and sacrifice. Jesus then points to His own life as the ultimate example: "The Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." Here, Jesus is reminding His disciples that His mission is about love poured out, a life of service, and even a death on the cross to save humanity.

As His disciples, this is our call too: to serve. In a world that often celebrates self-promotion, power, and personal gain, we are called to follow the way of Jesus, which is the way of humility and service. We are called to love others, to lift up the lowly, to care for the marginalized, and to use whatever authority or gifts we have for the good of others. Today, we can ask ourselves: How am I called to serve? It might be through small acts of kindness or through more intentional works of justice and charity. But no matter where or how, we are all invited to embody the love of Christ, remembering that in God's kingdom, the last will be first, and the greatest are those who serve.

May the Holy Spirit give us the grace to follow Jesus' example and live lives of service, knowing that it is in giving ourselves to others that we find true greatness and joy.

Q: How do I give?

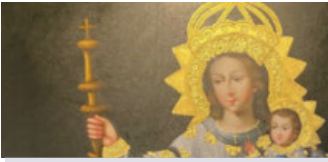

XXVIII DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

SU VIDA ES SERVICIO, ¡LA NUESTRA TAMBIÉN DEBERÍA SERLO!

Queridos discípulos, paz.

Este domingo las lecturas se centran en los temas del servicio, la humildad y el ejemplo de Jesucristo como Siervo Sufriente.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Santiago y Juan se acercan a Jesús con una petición audaz: quieren puestos de honor cuando Jesús llegue a su gloria. Ellos se imaginan puestos de poder y prestigio. Pero Jesús responde de una manera que ellos no esperan, y quizá tampoco nosotros. Les dice: "El que quiera ser grande entre vosotros, que sea vuestro servidor, y el que quiera ser el primero entre vosotros, que sea esclavo de todos". A primera vista, esto parece al revés. Solemos pensar que la grandeza viene acompañada de poder, autoridad y control. Pero Jesús le da la vuelta a esta idea. La verdadera grandeza, dice, no consiste en ser servido, sino en servir a los demás. Se trata de humildad y sacrificio. Jesús señala su propia vida como el mejor ejemplo: "El Hijo del Hombre no ha venido a ser servido, sino a servir, y a dar su vida en rescate por muchos". Aquí, Jesús está recordando a sus discípulos que su misión consiste en el amor derramado, una vida de servicio e incluso una muerte en la cruz para salvar a la humanidad.

Como discípulos suyos, ésta es también nuestra llamada: servir. En un mundo que a menudo celebra la autopromoción, el poder y el beneficio personal, estamos llamados a seguir el camino de Jesús, que es el camino de la humildad y el servicio. Estamos llamados a amar a los demás, a elevar a los humildes, a cuidar de los marginados y a utilizar cualquier autoridad o don que tengamos para servir a los demás. Hoy podemos preguntarnos: ¿Cómo estoy llamado a servir? Puede ser a través de pequeños actos de bondad o de obras de justicia y caridad más intencionadas. Pero no importa dónde ni cómo, todos estamos invitados a encarnar el amor de Cristo, recordando que en el reino de Dios los últimos serán los primeros y los más grandes son los que sirven.

Que el Espíritu Santo nos dé la gracia de seguir el ejemplo de Jesús y vivir vidas de servicio, sabiendo que es en la entrega a los demás donde encontramos la verdadera grandeza y alegría.

Que Dios nos bendiga.

ACTUALIZACIÓN DEL COLUMBARIO DE SANTA ROSA:

Después de 9 meses de planificación y preparación por nuestro Comité Exploratorio del Columbario, los resultados de la Encuesta de Apoyo a los Feligreses del Columbario de Santa Rosa de Lima requerida por la Diócesis de Nashville han sido totalizados. **LOS RESULTADOS DEMOSTRARON UN APOYO ABSOLUTO POR FELIGRESSES DE SANTA ROSA DE LIMA PARA CONSTRUIR UN COLUMBARIO EN ¡NUESTRO CAMPUS!** La participación y los resultados de la encuesta superaron a toda la Requisitos de la Diócesis de Nashville.

¿Cuántas familias parroquiales debían participar? La Diócesis requiere el 33% de familias parroquiales a participar. En el momento de la votación teníamos 3,361 familias en Santa Rosa. Votaron 1,248 de ellos. Así tuvimos una participación del 37.1%.

¿Cuántos votos se necesitaban para estar a favor de un columbario en Santa Rosa? La Diócesis requiere que el 75% de los votantes en la encuesta estén a favor de un columbario. Nuestros resultados muestran que 1,143 familias están a favor del columbario o el 91.6%.

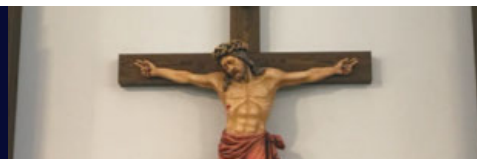

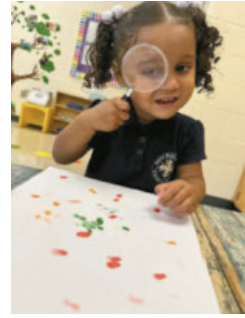
