**SAINT ROSE COLUMBARIUM UPDATE:** After 9 months of planning and preparation by our Columbarium Exploratory Committee, the results of the Saint Rose of Lima Columbarium Parishioner Support Survey required by the Diocese of Nashville have been totaled. **THE RESULTS DEMONSTRATED OVERWHELMING SUPPORT BY SAINT ROSE OF LIMA PARISHIONERS TO**

**BUILD A COLUMBARIUM ON OUR CAMPUS!** Participation and results of the survey exceeded all of the Diocese of Nashville's Requirements.

**How many parish families were required to participate?** The Diocese requires 33% of parish families to participate. At the time of voting we had 3,361 families at Saint Rose, 1,248 of them voted. Thus we had 37.1% participation.

**How many votes were required to be in favor of a columbarium at Saint Rose?** The Diocese requires 75% of those voting in the survey to be in favor of a columbarium. Our results show that 1,143 families are in favor of the columbarium or 91.6%.

**What will happen next?** These results and many more required facts and figures will be officially presented to the Diocese of Nashville for approval. Watch the parish Bulletin for future updates.

LOVE IS A CALL TO ACTION, NOT AN EMOTION!

Dear Fellow Disciples, peace.

The Gospel today calls us to reflect on the foundation of Christian life: love. When Jesus is asked to identify the greatest commandment, His answer is simple yet profound—“Love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, and mind” and “Love your neighbor as yourself” (Matthew 22:37-39). These two commandments are not separate but deeply interconnected. We cannot claim to love God if we neglect our neighbor, and true love for our neighbor flows from our love of God. The true disciple learns in the school of Jesus, the Church, to live and show love always.

In today’s world, where division, selfishness, and indifference often dominate, this message is especially urgent. Jesus invites us to see love as more than an abstract ideal or emotion. It’s a call to action: a life lived in service, kindness, and genuine care for others. To love God fully means to be willing to step out of our comfort zones, to encounter people with different needs, beliefs, or backgrounds, and to extend mercy and compassion. This is the way of discipleship, or better, the school of christian, catholic discipleship.

As we reflect on this teaching, we can ask ourselves: How do we live out this commandment of love in our daily lives? Do we show respect and care for those around us, especially those who are vulnerable, marginalized, or difficult to love? As followers of Christ, our mission is to make God’s love visible to the world.

May the Holy Spirit help us as we strive to love in a way that reflects God’s boundless love for us.

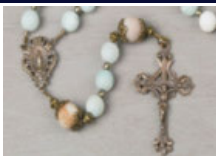

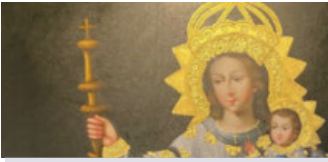


HEARING ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE

## XXX DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

### ¡EL AMOR ES UN LLAMADO A LA ACCIÓN, NO UNA EMOCIÓN!

Queridos discípulos, paz.

El Evangelio de hoy nos llama a reflexionar sobre el fundamento de la vida Cristiana: el amor. Cuando se le pide a Jesús que identifique el mandamiento más importante, su respuesta es simple pero profunda: “Ama al Señor tu Dios con todo tu corazón, alma y mente” y “Ama a tu prójimo como a ti mismo” (Mateo 22:37-39). Estos dos mandamientos no están separados sino profundamente interconectados. No podemos pretender amar a Dios si descuidamos a nuestro prójimo, y el verdadero amor por nuestro prójimo fluye de nuestro amor a Dios. El verdadero discípulo aprende en la escuela de Jesús, la Iglesia, a vivir y mostrar amor siempre.

En el mundo actual, donde a menudo dominan la división, el egoísmo y la indiferencia, este mensaje es especialmente urgente. Jesús nos invita a ver el amor como algo más que un ideal o una emoción abstracta. Es un llamado a la acción: una vida vivida en servicio, amabilidad y cuidado genuino por los demás. Amar a Dios plenamente significa estar dispuesto a salir de nuestra zona de confort, encontrar personas con diferentes necesidades, creencias o orígenes, y brindar misericordia y compasión. Éste es el camino del discipulado, o mejor, la escuela del discipulado Cristiano y Católico.

Al reflexionar sobre esta enseñanza, podemos preguntarnos: ¿Cómo vivimos este mandamiento del amor en nuestra vida diaria? ¿Mostramos respeto y cuidado por quienes nos rodean, especialmente aquellos que son vulnerables, marginados o difíciles de amar? Como seguidores de Cristo, nuestra misión es hacer visible el amor de Dios al mundo.

Que el Espíritu Santo nos ayude mientras nos esforzamos por amar de una manera que refleje el amor ilimitado de Dios por nosotros.

## ACTUALIZACIÓN DE HAITI:

La recaudación anual de fondos será el 16 y 17 de noviembre. Daniel Tillius regresará como embajador de Notre Dame de la Merci, nuestra parroquia gemela en Robillard. El párroco P. Doristin ha pedido nuestra ayuda para ampliar el edificio de la iglesia debido al hacinamiento. Está encantado de ver que la comunidad crece, pero a menudo no hay suficientes asientos. Las estimaciones para la expansión son de ~ \$ 10K. El padre ha pedido a sus feligreses que den en lo que puedan para el proyecto, que le gustaría llevar a cabo en 2025. Notre Dame también está investigando el costo de nuevos paneles solares para la clínica médica, la escuela y la iglesia porque los actuales no están funcionando bien. El generador que alimenta la rectoría tiene un inversor dañado que se puede reforzar con paneles nuevos. Se compartirá más información a medida que sepamos más. ¡Gracias!



## ACTUALIZACIÓN DEL COLUMBARIO DE SANTA ROSA:

Después de 9 meses de planificación y preparación por nuestro Comité Exploratorio del Columbario, los resultados de la Encuesta de Apoyo a los Feligreses del Columbario de Santa Rosa de Lima requerida por la Diócesis de Nashville han sido totalizados. **LOS RESULTADOS DEMOSTRARON UN APOYO ABSOLUTO POR FELIGRESES DE SANTA ROSA DE LIMA PARA CONSTRUIR UN COLUMBARIO EN ¡NUESTRO CAMPUS!** La participación y los resultados de la encuesta superaron a toda la Requisitos de la Diócesis de Nashville.

**¿Cuántas familias parroquiales debían participar?** La Diócesis requiere el 33% de familias parroquiales a participar. En el momento de la votación teníamos 3,361 familias en Santa Rosa. Votaron 1,248 de ellos. Así tuvimos una participación del 37.1%.

**¿Cuántos votos se necesitaban para estar a favor de un columbario en Santa Rosa?** La Diócesis requiere que el 75% de los votantes en la encuesta estén a favor de un columbario. Nuestros resultados muestran que 1,143 familias están a favor del columbario o el 91.6%.

**¿Qué pasará después?** Estos resultados y muchos más datos y cifras requeridos serán presentado oficialmente a la Diócesis de Nashville para su aprobación. Ver el boletín parroquial para futuras actualizaciones.

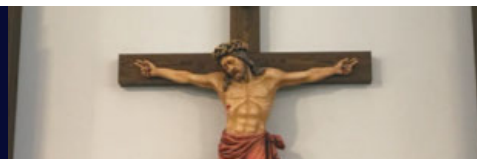

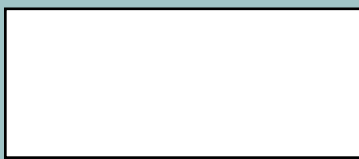
