

SAINT ROSE COLUMBARIUM UPDATE: After 9 months of planning and



preparation by our Columbarium Exploratory Committee, the results of the Saint Rose of Lima Columbarium Parishioner Support Survey required by the Diocese of Nashville have been totaled. THE RESULTS DEMONSTRATED OVERWHELMING SUPPORT BY SAINT ROSE OF LIMA PARISHIONERS TO BUILD A COLUMBARIUM ON OUR CAMPUS! Participation and results of the survey exceeded all of the Diocese of Nashville's Requirements.

How many parish families were required to participate? The Diocese requires 33% of parish families to participate. At the time of voting we had 3,361 families at Saint Rose. 1,248 of them voted. Thus we had 37.1% participation.

How many votes were required to be in favor of a columbarium at Saint Rose? The Diocese requires 75% of those voting in the survey to be in favor of a columbarium. Our results show that 1,143 families are in favor of the columbarium or 91.6%.

What will happen next? These results and many more required facts and figures will be officially presented to the Diocese of Nashville for approval. Watch the parish Bulletin for future updates.

Dear Fellow disciples, peace.

In today's readings, we see two women of great faith and generosity—the ow of Zarephath in the first reading and the widow in the Gospel. Both are poor and vulnerable, yet they each offer all they have, trusting that God will provide.

The widow of Zarephath gives her last bit of flour and oil to Elijah, trusting in his promise that God will sustain her. Similarly, in the Gospel, the poor widow quietly drops her two small coins into the temple treasury—offering everything she has. While her gift seems small, Jesus praises her for giving "all she had to live on." These examples show us that God values not the amount we give, but the love and trust behind our gifts. Real generosity is not measured by wealth, but by the willingness to give from our hearts, even when it costs us something.

To give our all with love is the attitude of the disciples who trusts in God's Divine Providence.

Today, let's reflect on our own faith and generosity. Are we willing to give to God and others, even when it requires a sacrifice? Let us trust that, like the widows, when we give with a sincere heart, God will always provide.

May the Holy Spirit help us to find joy and freedom in giving ourselves fully to God. God bless

Queridos Discípulos, paz.

En las lecturas de hoy vemos a dos mujeres de gran fe y generosidad: la viuda de Sarepta en la primera lectura y la viuda en el Evangelio. Ambos son pobres y vulnerables, pero cada uno ofrece todo lo que tiene, confiando en que Dios proveerá.



La viuda de Sarepta le da su último poco de harina y aceite a Elías, confiando en su promesa de que Dios la sustentará. De manera similar, en el Evangelio, La pobre viuda deja caer en silencio sus dos monedas en el tesoro del templo, ofreciendo todo lo que tiene. Si bien su don parece pequeño, Jesús la elogia por dar "todo lo que tenía para vivir".

Estos ejemplos nos muestran que Dios valora no la cantidad que damos, sino el amor y la confianza detrás de nuestros regalos. La verdadera generosidad no se mide por la riqueza, sino por la voluntad de dar de corazón, incluso cuando nos cueste algo.

ACTUALIZACIÓN DEL COLUMBARIO DE SANTA ROSA:

Después de 9 meses de planificación y preparación por nuestro Comité Exploratorio del Columbario, los resultados de la Encuesta de Apoyo a los Feligreses del Columbario de Santa Rosa de Lima requerida por la

Diócesis de Nashville han sido totalizados. LOS RESULTADOS DEMOSTRARON UN APOYO ABSOLUTO POR FELIGRESES DE SANTA ROSA DE LIMA PARA CONSTRUIR UN COLUMBARIO EN ¡NUESTRO CAMPUS! La participación y los resultados de la encuesta superaron a toda la Requisitos de la Diócesis de Nashville.

¿Cuántas familias parroquiales debían participar? La Diócesis requiere el 33% de familias parroquiales a participar. En el momento de la votación teníamos 3,361 familias en Santa Rosa. Votaron 1,248 de ellos. Así tuvimos una participación del 37.1%.

¿Cuántos votos se necesitaban para estar a favor de un columbario en Santa Rosa? La Diócesis requiere que el 75% de los votantes en la encuesta estén a favor de un columbario. Nuestros resultados muestran que 1,143 familias están a favor del columbario o el 91.6%.






