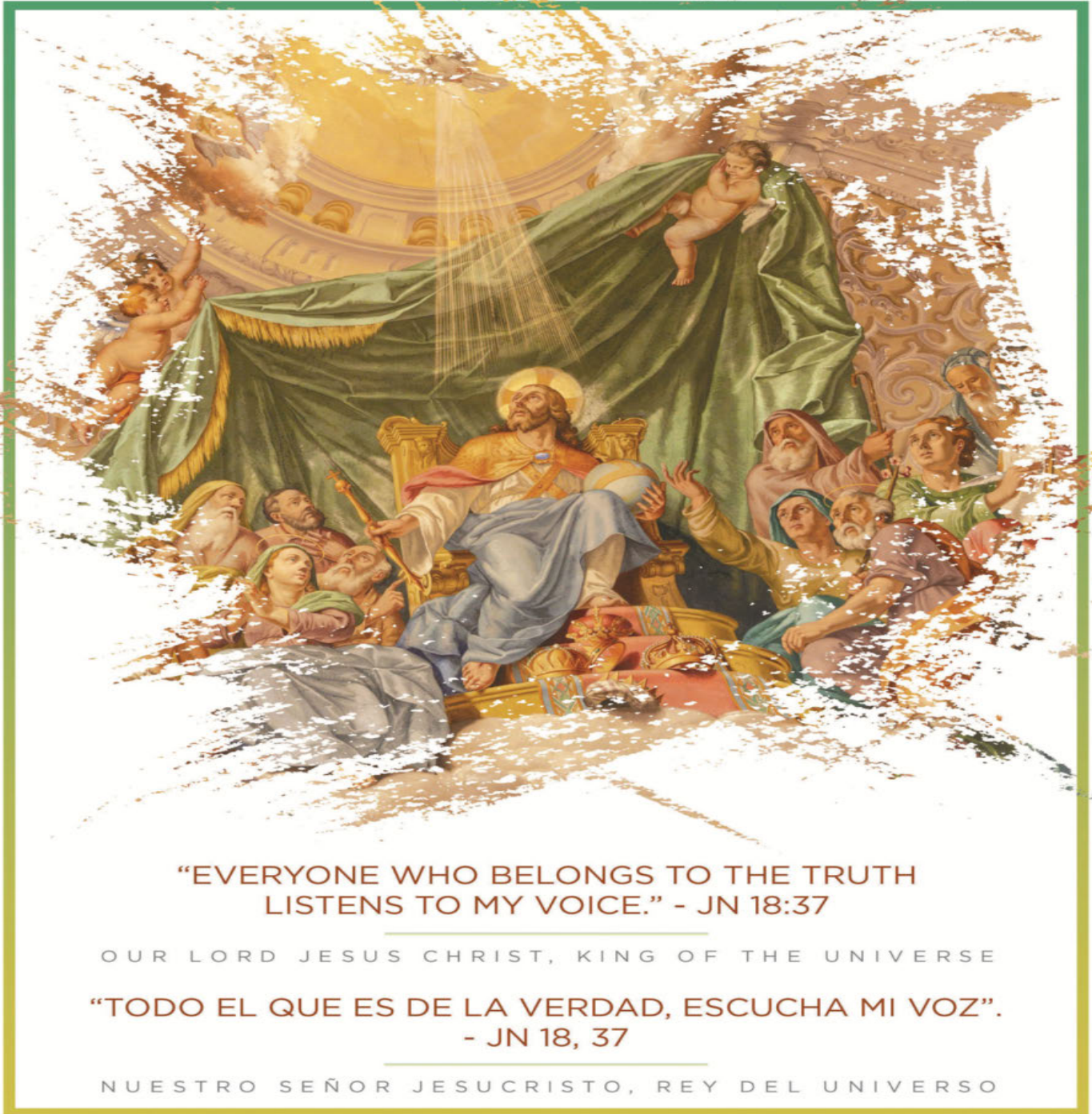

Dear Fellow Disciples, peace

Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King, a Solemnity that invites us to reflect on the kingship of Jesus—a kingship unlike any other. Jesus is not a king who seeks power or wealth; He is the Servant King who reigns through love, humility, and self-sacrifice. His throne is the cross, and His crown is made of thorns.

In the Gospel, we see a powerful image of His reign: a shepherd gathering His sheep, caring for the lost, the weak, and the broken. This reminds us that Christ’s kingdom is one of mercy and justice. Let us renew our commitment to follow our King, trusting that His reign will bring fulfillment, not only in our lives but in the entire world. With hearts open to His mercy, may we join Him in building a kingdom that reflects His boundless love.

May the Holy Spirit help to build a throne for Christ in our hearts, lives, families, community and in the whole world.

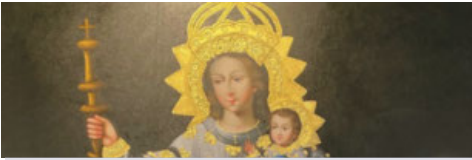


CHRISTMAS JEWELRY SALE

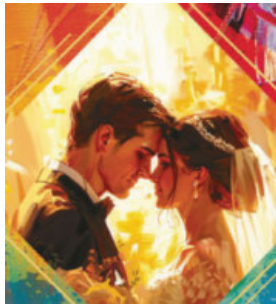

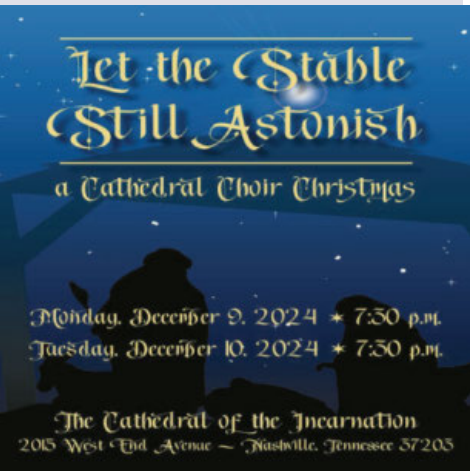

### Capital Campaign Development Projects:

Here's a brief update on each:

#### Marian Center –

Review sessions were held with the ONE Building Committee and other stakeholders. The architects will now begin the Contract Documents Phase. After we secure city approval, we will begin requesting bids for construction in early February. Construction could begin by summer.

#### McGivney Center (formerly the Stonewall House) –

We are awaiting approval of the Site Plan. Once we receive this we'll proceed with the final design and bidding. Phase 1 focuses on constructing ten parking spots.

#### Athletic Fields Relocation (New Gym Preparation) –

A more intensive study significantly reduced the identified wetland areas on the property. We have submitted the report to TDEC and the Corps of Engineers. With their approval, we'll have much more flexibility in the layout of the athletic fields.

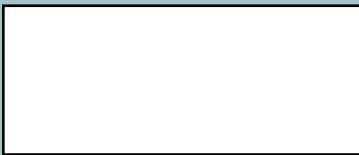
